ORIENTEERING

- Some areas mainly open, with large landforms but also with fine details, optimal for long, interesting sections;
 - Forest with a good runnability, alternating with portions with diversified vegetation - thickets, small glades, passages - in which the detailed reading of the covering offers the solutions for going through the sections;
 - Slopes with a high density of microrelief that requires a permanent, precise control of the positioning;
 - The area with lakes and ponds, a special, interesting specificity;
 - Rocky walls, boulders, confusing sinkholes;
 - Landslides, to be avoided as obstacles and to be used as landmarks for movement control.
- New area in a proportion of 70 – 100%, depending on the length of the course.

ORIENTEERING

- Special area for orienteering, on the slide of the Gurguiata peak, important mountain foot of the Bucegi Mountains:
- Terrace portions, determined by high, vertical rocky walls;
 - Areas with agglomerations of landmarks, rocks, towers, walls, boulders, sinkholes, hills, pits;
 - Forest, generally beech, with good runnability but also portions with fir forest, harder to run.
- The area has a newly mapped portion

- Forest with good runnability and areas with open land;
- Large landforms "sprinkled" with microdetails;

- + **ROMANIAN CUP** – overall 2 individual stages, LD & MD, WRE;
Classes: MF12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 21, 35, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, Open, Family;
- + **NATIONAL RELAY CHAMPIONSHIP** - club or county representative relays; classes MF 14, 18, 21, 120, 160, 190;
- + **CARPATHIAN O-TROPHY** - ranking of relays, those that participate in the National Relay Championship, as well as relays that are not representative of the club or the county, but respect the same age categories: MF14, 18, 21, 120,160,190;
- + **COMARNIC CITY CUP**
 - team ranking, consisting of two boys and a girl, by cumulating the times achieved by the team members at the stage of the relay and individual;
 - relay ranking;
 - individual ranking, by cumulating the times at the 2 individual stages;
Classes MF≤ 15 si MF≤19.
